

Huetepara Park Update:

Firstly, thank you so much for your initial support for the Huetepara Park in Lyall Bay. The following provides an update and an action plan that will help cement the project into Wellington City Council's (WCC) Long Term Plan (LTP).

Updates are as follows:

• First stage committed funds of \$100,000 from Wellington City Council parks with work to commence this year.

<u>Project preliminary voted into the WCC long term plan in stages:</u>

• Phase 1: \$300,000 towards build 1 - 3 years

• Phase 2: \$1,000,000 towards build 4 - 10 years
