We know your time at Lyall Bay School will be the Best!

Data about our ākonga (learners) was shared at the board meeting last week. This data is taken from the information that kaiako (teachers) have already shared with you for your tamaiti (child) at the end of last term in reading, writing and maths. As a whole school we are doing the best in maths, then writing then reading. We are very aware of the effects a pandemic has had on wellbeing and learning, especially for those tamariki who have started in the past two years. We have found that Learning Through Play supports the wellbeing of tamariki, kaiako are very aware of the needs of our ākonga and have different programmes in place to support their learning. Data around **Pūmanawa-ā-ākonga** (Beating Heart of the Learner – or graduate profile) and **values** were also shared. This information has been gathered from timely comments and how kaiako have 'tagged' the different areas of Pūmanawa-ā-ākonga and values. **Hiranga excellence** is the most tagged value and **Communicator** the most tagged Pūmanawa-ā-ākonga.

Mask wearing is required for those tamariki in Yrs 4-6, and an option for anyone else who would like to wear a mask. It is expected that, while inside, masks will be worn. They do not need to be worn when outside. We have air purifiers in Onepū, Maranui, and the hall. Huetepara classes have great ventilation and larger spaces to move around in. Thank you to Rohan who took on the role of making sure these were set up and to write out the instructions, so everyone can understand them. What a show of **whakapono**, Rohan.

We are opening a **ballot** for out-of-zone enrolments. The ballot closes on 21st October at 5pm. If you know of anyone wanting to enrol, please let them know.

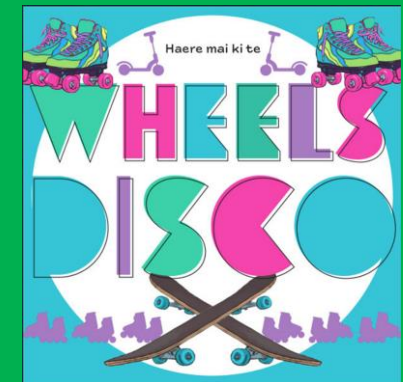
