I hope you all had a wonderful Queen's Birthday weekend. These three-day weekends need to be compulsory!!

We are moving along well with all the preparation that it takes for a school production. Our dates and times are now set. We have matinee and evening performances on the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> of June. As explained in last week's newsletter, we want to ensure that we are all as safe as possible from COVID, so audience group sizes are limited to 25 people. Each hub is performing in their own space, and there will be some time spent outside, so please dress for the weather! The matinee performances will mean that the lighting effects will not be as effective, but you will see all live performances. For the evening sessions, our youngest tamariki from Ahu will be movie stars. Matinee sessions start at 12.45, 1.05, 1.25 and 1.45pm. They run for approximately 1 ½ hours. Evening sessions run for the same length of time and start at 4.55, 5.15, 5.35, 5.55 and 6.15pm.

Tamariki can return to school **after** their seven day isolation period, this means they **return to school on day eight**, as long as they are feeling well.
