## Namaste

Tomorrow we are half way through the term! Can you believe it? [Timely comments](#) about learning for your tamariki will continue to be sent to you through HERO until the last couple of weeks of school, so please keep an eye out for them. You can comment on these for your tamariki and the kaiako to see, they love getting the feedback too. You will also receive a post about where your tamariki are learning in relation to the curriculum. This will be in the last two weeks of school.

As you will know, there was a [Public Health Order](#) published on 25<sup>th</sup> October and to be enacted from November 16<sup>th</sup>. This PHO mandates vaccinations for all staff, volunteers, contractors, etc, who are working onsite during times tamariki are here. Lyall Bay School adheres to this mandate and follows the advice from MoE and MoH. If you wish to [volunteer](#) to coach, go on a trip, help in the class, etc, you will need to provide Melanie ([principal@lyallbay.school.nz](mailto:principal@lyallbay.school.nz)) with your vaccination status (one vaccine by Nov 15<sup>th</sup> and two by 1<sup>st</sup> Jan), then you can contact kaiako and they will arrange the best time for you to come in to help out. With this PHO we will continue with our Level 2 protocols, but kaiako will not be on the gates. We [trust](#) that you will drop your tamariki off at the gate after 8.30am and they will sanitise when in the classroom. You can continue to come onsite to pick up, but please continue to stay [socially distanced](#) in the [designated areas](#). [Do not enter classes or go on verandahs](#) and you will also need to wear a [mask](#). If you need to come onsite at any other time, please call ahead to the office. If you wish to speak to a teacher, please make an appointment, so a suitable space can be made available.

We are starting to put together our [classes for 2022](#) in the next few weeks. If you would like some input into the kind of environment that your child does best in, then please let me know. Kaiako are not yet in set spaces, so [please do not request a particular teacher](#) as that teacher may not be teaching that year level in 2022! We also ask that you do not ask for your child to be with a particular group of friends. This can get tricky if other parents have asked for something quite different.
